

# Types of Primary Lesions

Lesion	< 1cm diameter	> 1cm diameter
<b>Flat, non-palpable</b>	Macule <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Freckle</li></ul>	Patch <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Vitiligo</li></ul>
<b>Raised, flat, palpable</b>	Papule <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• wart</li></ul>	Plaque <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Psoriasis</li></ul>
<b>Deep, palpable, solid</b>	Nodule <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• dermatofibroma</li></ul>	Tumor <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Lipoma</li></ul>
<b>Elevated, fluid-filled (clear fluid)</b>	Vesicle <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Herpes simplex virus (HSV)</li><li>• Herpes zoster (chickenpox)</li></ul>	Bulla <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Bullous pemphigoid</li></ul>
